

Ford Will Distribute \$800,000 To Nebraska Ford Owners Aug. 15



HENRY FORD

June 16th, 1903, the Ford Motor Company was officially born to the commercial life of the world.
At the end of the first fiscal year 1,708 cars had been built. The factory payroll held the names of 311 employees. A branch house was established in New York City.
At the close of the twelfth fiscal year (July 31, 1915), over 300,000 cars will have been made and sold within the year. There are 35 branches and 25 assembling plants (any one of which does more business annually than the entire business of the company in its first two years). 25,000 employees, with 18,000 on the factory payroll. Business first year, \$1,000,000.00. Business for 1915, \$150,000,000.00.
