NEW TORK, March 1.—The speculative element, which had the market quite to itself for the greater part of the acasion, was plainly inclined to draw mere favorable inference today from latest developments in Washington and abroad and prices hardened appreciably. Trading was the lightest and most circumscribed of any recent day, but the undertone, save for a few specialties, denoted quiet confidence.

Gains of one to more than three points were irregularly distributed, except in the railway division, which was extremely apathetic. Better known isaues of the war group contributed more than their proportionate quiet with exceptional activity in a few of the equipment shares. Olls also scored smartly, Mexican Petroleum and Texas company responding to the extent of three points or more on reports of discoveries of freshoil wells in Mexico and along that border. For awhile United States Steel surrendered its active leadership to such ill-assorted issues as Corn Products and Baldwin Locomotive, the former showing strength, while Baldwin Locomotive lost ground, which was made up later.
