

ALL 5 BANDITS HELD FOR TRIAL WITHOUT BONDS

Harry Williams Pleads Not Guilty in Police Court; Women Are Kept in Custody as Witnesses.

Frank Martin, Harry Williams, B. C. Kirke and Sam Stone, gunmen, diamond bandits and alleged murderers of Detective Rooney, were arraigned in police court Saturday afternoon.

Tom McKay, wounded bandit, who is in a hospital, and "John Doe," the sixth gunman, who escaped after a pitched battle between detectives and robbers, were named in the complaint. Deputy County Attorney Abbott read the complaint against the gunmen.

First degree murder was the charge. All were bound over to district court without bonds.

Williams, spokesman for the bandits, pleaded not guilty for all of them.

Mrs. Kirke and her sister, Anna Uhl, who were arrested in the house with the bandits after the battle, were arraigned as state witnesses.

Mrs. Kirke's bond was fixed at \$1,000. The Uhl girl's bond was fixed at \$700.

Kirke was the only member of the gang to smile during the proceedings in police court.

The rest of the alleged murderers and gunmen maintained a grim expression.

Few spectators were in the court room when the bandits were arraigned.

January Came Within One of Making Record

Only one January in the last 30 years was colder than the January of this year.

According to the statement issued on the month's weather by the weather bureau, the mean temperature for January, 1918, was 13 degrees above zero.

January, 1888, the month of the big blizzard, had a mean temperature of only 8 above zero.

There was a total deficiency of 24 degrees in the temperature of January this year compared with the normal temperature of the month taken from the records of the last 46 years.

The highest temperature last month was 51 above and the lowest was 22 below zero.

The highest ever recorded in Omaha in January was 63 above zero in 1895.

The lowest ever recorded was 32 below zero in 1884.

The total wind movement during the month was 7,978, an average of nearly 11 miles an hour.

German Aliens to the Number of 300 Register

Three hundred German aliens have called this week at the city council chamber to receive registration affidavits which are to be returned next week with photographs.

The law requires that these aliens must register during the week of February 4 to 9.

Blanks were issued this week as a matter of convenience and to equalize the work.

The registrars will be on duty in the council chamber next week, from 8 o'clock a. m. to 8 o'clock p. m. each day.

All German aliens of Greater Omaha are expected to register at the city hall.

Those residing in the county, outside of Omaha, should report to their postoffices.

Both complaints against George Levey, former proprietor of the United Trading company, were dismissed by Judge Fitzgerald in police court Saturday morning.

In the first complaint, that of obtaining money under false pretenses, the judge ruled the evidence showed that Levey obtained the money under "future promises and not under present facts."

In the second, he said that there had been no evidence of personal representation by Levey of the existence of a lottery.
