Spirits Is Boosted **Under New Tax Act**

Increase to \$4 a Gallon Agreed Upon by G. O. P. Leaders -Will Not Increase Postage Rater.

Washington, Oct. 7 .- A tax of \$4 a gallon on all alcoholic spirits withdrawn from bond for industrial, medicinal or any other purposes, has been agreed upon by republican leaders as a part of the new tax revision pro-gram. This is an increase of \$1.80 a gallon and is expected to yield \$75,000,000 additional revenue each

The proposal to repeal the \$2,000 exemption allowed corporations was abandoned on the ground that it would work too great a hardship on the small corporations. leaders also were said to have decided on a flat corporation income tax of 15 per cent in place of a 10 and 15 per cent rate.

Reduce Income Exemption.


A maximum income surtax rate of 50 per cent would apply in the case of incomes in excess of \$200,000 instead of \$500,000 as proposed

Red Cross Man Will Speak on First Aid To Postal Employes

In accordance with the plan of the United States postal department. in co-operation with the National Red Cross society, to organize wel-fare societies in the postoffices of the nation, Capt. G. R. T. Fisher of the Omaha Red Cross will deliver lecture today at noon to employes of the South Side postoffice on the Possibility of First Aid Knowl-

edge."
The lecture will be given with practical demonstrations to furnish instructions to letter carriers and other employes of the postoffice on methods of first aid in case of accident. It is pointed out that a letter carrier on his rounds often sees accidents in which he could aid if possessed of advice on treatment, and employes of a postoffice could be of service in case of sudden illness or accident among workers. This is the first of a series of lectures that will be given to the South Side employes.
