Butterflies.

The color of the first butterfly you see in the spring indicates the color of a dress you will have in the course of the year. That is a widespread superstition, both in this country and Europe. In some sections they say that the new dress will be given you and down in Alabama they say that you must bite the head off of the butterfly and throw it over your shoulder in order to be sure of the new garment. Another variant is that when you see the first butterfly of spring you must wish for a new dress and you will get it.

There are many other superstitions with regard to the butterfly based upon its ancient symbolism of the soul and as an insect into which soul transmigration. Thus the Solomon Islanders frequently chose a butterfly as the creature into which they wish their souls to pass after death and in some sections of India the butterfly is supposed to contain the soul of a witch. But the superstition, with regard to the butterfly and a new dress arises from no such purely mystic conception. It would appear to be more largely materialistic and based on analogy, as the butterfly comes forth in the spring from its crystals in a new dress. There is, of course, the ancient, primitive idea that mystic is a mystic creature entering into the superstition; otherwise it would not be able to thus control the future.
