

France Prepares To Defend Stand For Submarines

Bitter Opposition Expected From Great Britain to Domands for Increase In Tonnage.

By HENRY WALES. Washington, Dec. 8 .- While the "big three" are seeking agreement on the "accord in policy" the French delegation is preparing to defend its stand for a larger tonnage of capital ships and more and bigger subma-
