New York, Feb. 7.—The particular interest of financial markets today was fairly divided between the further advance in wheat price, and the continued upward sweep of sterling exchange.

Except for central Europe, foreign exchange on practically all European markets today showed a downward movement. In the wheat market, the rate moved forward 11-16 to \$4.34-5-8, which compared with \$4.27 a week ago, \$4.19 1-2 a month ago, and a maximum rate of \$4.21-1-8 in the two and a half preceding years.
