

### Zimman Explains His Action on Dispensary

City Commissioner H. R. Zimman, who has charge of office assignments and general maintenance of the city hall, requested yesterday that his position be made clear in connection with the removal of the public school dental dispensary from the third floor.

"Several months ago," said the commissioner, "I went before the buildings committee of the board of education and was given to understand that there was a disposition in that quarter to get rid of the dental dispensary and the thought was that if I ordered the dispensary out of the

city hall, that would meet the situation. I replied that I did not want the matter to rest on that basis; that my interest was to use the space of the city hall to best advantage for city purposes and I took the position that the dispensary was a public school adjunct and should be housed by the board of education. "It is my opinion that the school

authorities can find space for the dispensary on the sixth floor of the city hall if they wish to do so. The sixth floor is use exclusively for public school purposes."
