CHAPTER XXI. An Untold Secret. All the field and forest people soon knew that at last Jimmy Rabbit had invited Nimble Deer to his party.



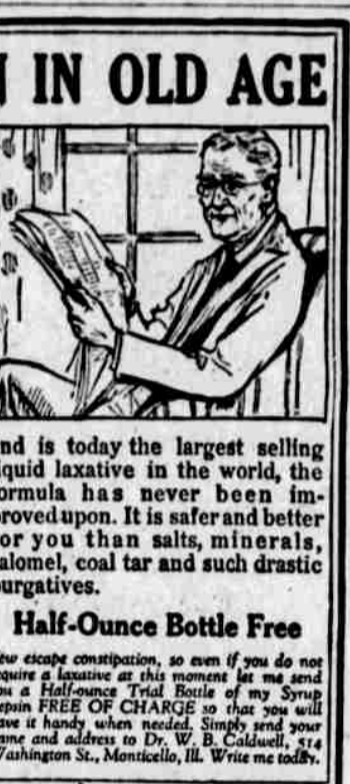
"I hear you're going to the party," Billy said to him. "Where's Jimmy Rabbit?" he asked Mr. Crow.
