**PRESIDENTS WILL GATHER.**

Meeting of Western College Presidents at Missouri.

We clip the following from the Missouri Independent, as being of interest to Nebraskans:

"One of the most important educational conferences of late years will be held here April 26, when the presidents of all the state universities in the north half of the Mississippi valley will attend. It is proposed to make this an annual conference. No set program has been adopted, and the conference will last several days. The following educators have signified their intention of attending: James Burrill Angell, president of the University of Michigan; C. H. Van Hise, acting-president of the University of Wisconsin; Cyrus Northrop, president of the University of Minnesota; W. O. Thompson, president of the University of Ohio; William Lowe Bryan, president of the University of Indiana; Andrew Sloan Draper, president of the University of Illinois; George Edwin MacLean, president of the University of Iowa; Frank Strong, chancellor of the University of Kansas; Elisha Benjamin Andrews, chancellor of the University of Nebraska; James H. Baker, president of the University of Colorado; Webster Merrillfield, president of the University of North Dakota; Garret Droppers, president of Purdue University, and Richard Henry Jesse, president of the University of Missouri, who will act as host.
