His hints as to interviews may be summed up in these words: Be natural and frank, and be sure you really know what you are talking about.

Superintendent Stephens then proceeded to speak of some qualifications nectssary for retaining a position, carriage, voice, quality of eye, earnestness.

In connection with the latter he emphasized the kind of facts (type facts) which should be presented. Results should be those which typefy things of real value. He also laid stress on the power to develop a genuine interest, and, coupled with this, thoroughness. As to the manner of managing a school he suggested personality, aptitude in presenting, magnetism and sympathy.

Superintendent Stephens' address was a forcible presentation of facts which must be of service to those who are about to enter the public schools as a teacher.

Professor Luckey next called upon Professor Jackson to make some remarks as to the permanent club. The plan is to hold a meeting some time during commencement week, probably on Alumni Day.
