Letter From An Alumnus.

The following letter from an alumnus has been kindly handed to us for publication:

Virginia City, Mont. Dr. G. E. Condra, Lincoln, Neb.

Dear Friend: I have been trying to find time to write to you ever since I came, but I have been so busy,

I get out every time I have a chance and study the mountains. They are a wonderful study to me.

This is in Alder gulch, which is only eighteen miles long, and about \$200,-000,000 have been taken from the bed of the stream. Senator Millard, of Nobraska was the first school director of this school and in this place he made his start. His son has a mine eight miles up the gulch from here.

We have an assay outfit in school and I am teaching assaying. , go to the mines and learn of the assayers and then come back and teach my boys. I have found something that I can't tell what it is. I am sending you a piece in a little box by mail.

When the weather was good I took my physical geography class out every other night for a ramble over the hills, and on Saturday the pupils would take me into the mountains.

At the State Teachers' association I met most of the leading school men of the state. I met Wm. . Fraser, Madge Ames, Elva Dempster and the Row boys, all of Nebraska Universi-

We have cleven grades in our school. We also have a good atmetic association. About 50 boys and girls play basket ball once a week in the city auditorium.

We will have a county field day in the spring. Our business men have purchased two medals for our boys, to be given field day. We gave an athletic entertainment, made \$52.50.

There are so many interesting things here. A whole mountain that has slipped 1,500 feet sidewise, and places that have dropped hundreds of feet.

There is a good range of mountains with fossils on its top, and a broad valley that has been dammed up by lava, and when it broke over made a canyon, where a power congany has en electric power plant and sends the current eighty miles to Butte, where are the greatest copper mines in the world, and at Anaconds is the largest copper smalter in the world. They tak, cooper mixed with sulphur put it in smelter-gas good to boilers. heats water, runs engines, which pump air to smelter, which meas ore, and all this without a pound of coal. All done by the sulphur in the ore. It looks wonderful to me.
