Adds Impetus to Movement.

With this backing of the association, greater efforts will probably be made by all schools that can offer proper facilities in these lines of study, and there will be good openings for teachers who are qualified in them.

At this annual meeting, the accredited schools of the states over which the association acts are reinstated and the schools which have raised their standards to conform with those of the association are newly accredited. The Nebraska list, which Inspector Reed presented to the association and which was accepted, was as follows:

This is the list of secondary schools which, under the rules of the association, can send students to the University without a preliminary examination. The North Central Association is very conservative, believing that such action will work to the highest interests of the schools and the association. It aims to accredit only those schools which possess organization, teaching force, standards of scholarship, esprit de corps, etc., of such character as will commend them to any educator, college or university in the north central territory.

Mr. Orr also announces that the cafeteria is for the convenience and use of the University students and that outside trade is not solicited, as the establishment is not run on a money-making plan and is solely for the benefit of students. The room has

already proved inadequate and will be made still more so if outside people continue to patronize it. Visitors are always welcome and the management will always extend a welcome to all of them, but it must be remembered that the cafeteria is only for the students and employees of the University.
