

### BOOMING A NEBRASKAN

Elton Fulmer, Graduate of University  
in 1887, May Succeed Dr.  
Wiley.

A full-sized boom is now on for the appointment of Elton Fulmer, chemist of the state of Washington and graduate of Nebraska University, to the office made vacant by the recent resignation of Dr. Wiley as head of the United States bureau of chemistry.

Mr. Fulmer graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1887 with the degree of bachelor of science. Nebraska alumni are falling in behind the boom of their fellow-graduate in a most loyal manner.

Among those back of Mr. Fulmer is Chancellor Samuel Avery of the State University, who has written a strong letter of endorsement to President Taft. The appointment, although nominally made by Secretary Wilson, will undoubtedly be made in actuality by the president.

Mr. Fulmer graduated a year before the Chancellor did, and as an assistant professor had the latter in one of his classes for a year. Mr. Fulmer is a brother of Chancellor Fulmer of Nebraska Wesleyan University.

Other influential Nebraska alumni are also working hard in the interests of Mr. Fulmer. All of the Nebraska delegation in congress has been advised in the matter and their support solicited. It has been promised by all who have been heard from so far.

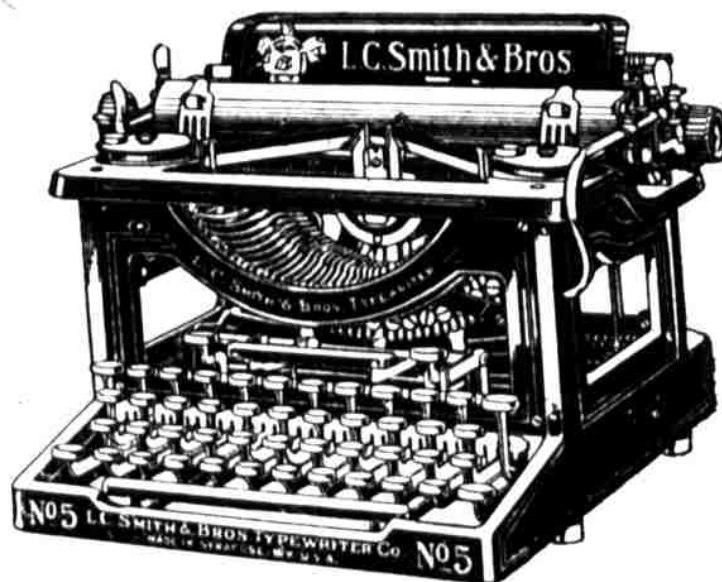
