**HERE'S ELIGIBILITY RULE.**

Mandate of Committee Made Public Again for Benefit of Students.

In view of the fact that considerable discussion has arisen over the eligibility rule of the University, the eligibility committee has seen fit to make it public again. The rule follows:

"All students desiring to participate in any student activity for which the University requires a definite scholastic standard shall first secure certification of eligibility from the secretary of the Committee on Delinquent Students.

"Before permitting a student to become a member of a team, take part in any contest, participate in any pre-
