DR. AVERY SPEAKS TO OMAHA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ON HIGHER EDUCATION.

"The average man without a college education is like a ten-horse power engine," declared the chancellor in the course of his address. "It is the man who has the college education that can climb the steep hill of success, while the man of ten horse-power learning must climb in the lower altitudes."
