

### CAMPAIGN FOR SIGNATURES

THE COMMITTEE OF FIFTY CIRCULATES PETITIONS.

TO BE PRESENTED TO REGENTS

Single Tax Encourages Little Opposition From Students, Which Assures It of Success.

The committee of fifty, as announced in yesterday's Nebraskan, reported at the "Rag" office at 7:30 this morning and secured the petitions of the student body to the Board of Regents requesting that the single tax system be instituted at Nebraska. During the morning hours the committee will circulate this petition through all the classes to ascertain the favor of the student body towards the movement as evidenced by their signatures, and at the June meeting of the Regents the petition will be placed in the hands of that body, where the matter will depend upon their approval.

So far the single tax idea at Nebraska has met with no material opposition and it is the expectation of all backing the movement that it will pass with the approval of every student in the school. As explained at yesterday's convocation and in the numerous posters on the campus, the single tax system has been a success and a benefit to all concerned at some thirty-five or forty schools in which it has been tried. In a progressive school as that of Nebraska, where numerous new precedents and traditions have been set and followed and where new reforms are continually being agitated for the benefit of the school in general, there is little doubt that the new and valuable movement will meet with the enthusiastic approval of the whole student body.
