The rule of the Regents which was adopted last year, abolishing examinations, is not proving so popular with the students as was expected. Numerous one-hour quizzes, instead of one two-hour exam, as in former years, are being generally adopted by the professors. Having to cram for these tests, and also to prepare lessons in four or five other courses each day, keeps the average student busy.

The unusual amount of hot weather experienced this year aggravates the trouble of the students and a majority of them would probably like to see the old scheme of two-hour exams brought back.
