

**MUSEUM RECEIVES MODEL**

Miniature Brontosarus To Be Placed Upon Exhibition—Fossil of Animal Shows It Was a Monster.

**FEMUR BONE IS IDENTIFIED**

Has anybody seen the Wampus? The Brontosarus Femur is no longer to remain in obscurity. A model of the Brontosaurus is being encased in glass, and will be stationed by the side of the huge Brontosaurus thigh bone which now occupies a prominent position in the lower hall of the museum.

Visitors to the museum, who have wondered to what animal the bone belonged, can now understand from whence it came by glancing at this reproduction of the Brontosaurus. There is a miniature man standing beside the model, and the contrast seems to indicate that the monster was sixteen feet in height and twenty-five feet in length. This may seem to be a "fish story" to many persons but there are specimens of the animal mounted in eastern museums which are ninety feet in length.

The Brontosaurus looks very much like a cross between a graffe and a rhinoceros, with its awkward body and eight-foot neck. The thigh bone belonging to the museum was obtained from the wilds of Wyoming. It weighs over one-half of a ton and a derrick was necessary in order to mount it.

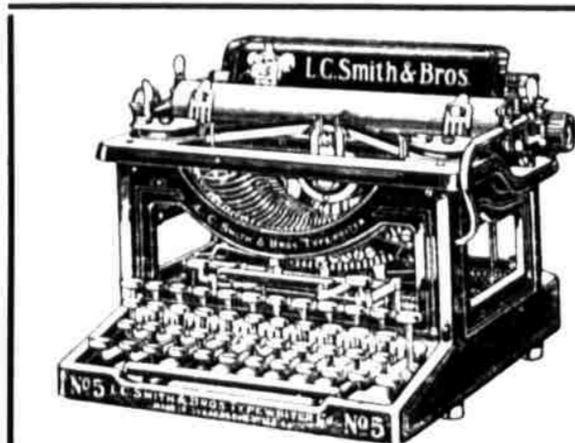
