**Beltzer's Men Take Fast Game From Wesleyan University**

The Cornhuskers treated the Wesleyan Coyotes to a drubbing yesterday afternoon to the tune of thirteen to six on the Wesleyan field. The game was played in a bad wind which made feature playing impossible and caused the play to drag throughout. Nebraska started the scoring in the first round and only once were the Coyotes able to get a sniff at the bacon. This happened in the third when they got next to Jimmy for three scores. A walk, three two-baggers and a single in the fifth netted Nebraska four scores and put the game out of reach of the hungry Coyotes.

Although Rodman's mound offerings were bumped for twelve safe ones, he worked strong in pinches and refused to issue a complimentary ticket to first base. Seven of the opposing batsmen swung futilely at his deceptive slants and succeeded only in displacing the ozone. Chamberlain's work for the Coyotes was not so effective. While he allowed only ten hits, he walked eleven men and this was a material factor in swelling Nebraska's score.


