Each active duty outside of school work is counted as a certain number of points, the number varying according to the responsibility assumed The maximum number of points is twenty per year. With such a plan no one is overburdened with outside responsibilities and the university honors are more equally distributed.

Many schools have adopted the plan of having senior advisors for the freshman girls. Each senjor chooses the name of a first year girl and sees to it that she is properly registered.

She also escorts her chosen freshman to open university social affairs and aids her in becoming acquainted with the student body. One of the most pleasing features of the Wisconsin campus is Lathrop hall, a building which is strictly for the use of university women students. In it are rest rooms and cloak rooms, a theatre, a dancing hall, reading rooms a large gymnasium and a swimming frequently, provide more economical pool. Miss Daniels experienced a hope that Nebraska too might have a women's building in the near future.

difficulty, but to rely entirely upon if would be futile. Not only would such a process be slow and cumbersome, but it could not materially develop ac quaintenceship. We must adopt some plan whereby we can get the student body together. A plan which would go far toward this end and arouse enthusiasm, would be the formation of a student cabinet composed of representatives from every society, class, college and organization in school. A plan of proportional representation could be adopted. The meetings of this body should be open to both students and faculty. Discussion of University problems should be limited not merely to the cabinet but to the whole school. Such a body might have powers similar to the Innocents, but much broader in scope. This is not a revolutionary idea but a step towards greater democracy in class control.


