

GOPHERS IN FINE STATE

WILLIAMS ARRIVES WITH HIS SQUAD SAFELY FRIDAY MORNING.

HOLD AFTERNOON PRACTICE

Is Confident of Victory, Although on Lookout for Surprises by Stiehm's Men.

Coch Williams and his Gopher cohorts arrived in Lincoln Friday morning at 11:15 over the Burlington. They immediately went to the Lindell Hotel, where they are staying. Here Guy Reed met them with a machine and whisked the coach and Captain Aylsworth off to the rally, at that time in progress at the Armory.

In the afternoon the team went to the Country Club in automobiles and held a short secret practice. Coach Williams was seemingly confident of victory, although he made the statement that as Nebraska had given him some hard starts in the past he did not intend to be caught napping this afternoon. His team is in good shape seemingly with no men injured, and all in the prime of playing condition.

No rooters came with the northern team, although a few may come this morning. The majority of Minnesota men, however, consider the game with Wisconsin later in the season the best game and will attend that. A large number of alumni who live in the state have engaged seats in a special section and will cheer the woodsmen on to victory.

EXPECT RECORD ATTENDANCE

Weather Permitting, 13,000 Rooters Will Fill Nebraska Field This Afternoon.

MORE SEATS SOLD THAN EVER BEFORE.

Up to date there are 4,100 student tickets sold. This is a record break for all previous years, being 250 more than was sold last year. Besides this some 8,500 seats have been sold or reserved for today's game. It certainly looks like the Nebraska homecoming is a real homecoming.

The total number of people at the game will be the total capacity of "The Husker Field." With the present arrangement over 13,000 will be accommodated. Nebraska field in its history has never held such a large crowd.

There is still room for 4,500 people—that is, only 400 more tickets will be sold. A large new stand 150 feet long, has been erected at the west end of the field, which will accommodate at least 1,500, while new stands erected on the south will accommodate more than 1,000, and a standing platform on the east of the field will give standing room for an overflow of about 700.
