see that Towle gets a square deal, but of course if the eligibility rule bars him, we will have to abide by it."

The rule in question reads as follows:

"No student shall participate in intercollegiate athletics for more than three college years in the aggregate, the three years to begin with the first semester of the year in which the man first participates. It is understood that if a man enters college in the second semester, his college year begins with the second semester."

It is contended by some that because Towle did not play until the second semester two years ago, he will be eligible to play the first semester next year. However, the clause, "the three years to begin with the first semester of the year in which the man first participates," seems to refute that theory.

Coch Stiehm and other athletic officials yesterday refused to comment on the case, saying that there is nothing to do but wait for the decision of the eligibility committee.
