It is surprising what a large amount of corn there is throughout this and adjoining counties. It is not so plentiful right here in this locality, where the June hail played havoc, but there is enough for use and some to sell even here. But throughout the country there is an immense quality of corn. As we passed down the B. & M. line last week nearly every farmer along the route, not only had his cribs full but there were great piles on the ground. Chas Snyder, son of Representative J. M. Snyder was at the State capital trying to secure an appointment for a position in the legislature. He came home, however, with nothing but disappointment as a reward for his efforts. We understand that he lays the cause of his defeat at the door of Congressman elect, W. L. Greene, who it seems was very conspicuous in the lobby rooms. It is said that no one without Mr. Greene's recommendation would apply. The NORTHWESTERN would have been pleased to see Charley get a position, and if that honorable body had listened less to the dictations of Mr. Greene and done the right thing by Sherman county he would now be listed with the great army of employees at the capitol building.

George E. Benschoter, editor of the Loup City NORTHWESTERN, announced the facts to the world through his paper that he is after the Loup City Postoffice. Benschoter came to Loup City before the county of Sherman was organized and has passed through several sieges of grass-toppers, Indians and populism. George's bird head would make a great reflector behind the little pigeon holes and his long practice setting long primer and patent medicine ads would prove valuable to him in distributing mail and whistling "Home, Sweet Home" as an accompaniment. But it is understood in this part of the country that Judge Wall is the Tobe Burlington of the Castor in Sherman County and if Benschoter can get the Ingersoll-tongued gentleman as a running mate he may get the privilege of distributing his own papers,—Ord Quiz.

The above article from the pen of the editor of the Ord Quiz would seem to indicate that our chances for getting to be P. M. here depends entirely upon the endorsement of Judge Wall. While we believe that an endorsement from Mr. Wall would do us no harm, yet we are inclined to think that a person should stand on his own merits when seeking a position of public trust. What we want is an endorsement from the people, and especially the republicans, boys, not particularly from any one republican but from the largest possible number. If we get this we merit the position. Our petition contains the names of nearly all the republicans who get their mail at this place. It also contains nearly all of the representative business men of the town.

The Edgar Post severely criticises the action of Anin, the Washington correspondent of the State Journal, for his constant attacks upon Senator Thurston and his opposition regarding the conformation of McHugh. The Post says: "So persistent is he in his attacks on the senator that suspicion is becoming general that he is animated by personal motives rather than a desire for the public good. Under ordinary circumstances we are of the opinion that the democrats should be allowed to settle their own squabbles, but in the matter of the judiciary, senators should not allow partizan feeling to influence them to submit to ill advised appointments by the executive. If McHugh is confirmed he will not only be district judge for the state, but will also be, practically United States district and circuit courts for the district of Nebraska, and these positions require judicial training and ability of the highest order. It may be that McHugh has these qualifications. We do not know. We do know, however, that Senator Thurston is on the ground and in possession of all the facts in the case, and we fully believe that he is acting conscientiously and consistently with these facts. Thurston is responsible to the republican party in Nebraska for his official acts, and he would be doing both his and his state an irreparable injury if he gave his sanction to a man who is in any way unfit for the high office of federal judge. Senator Thurston has every means of judging as to McHugh's fitness for the office and has concluded that he is not the proper man for the place, and when it comes to deciding between Thurston's ability to judge of such fitness and honesty in drawing conclusions, and the ability and honesty of Anin in the same connection, we will be excused if we take the senator every time. The insinuation of the Journal correspondent that the sound money democrats supported McKinley in the recent campaign for the sake of the political spoils they might get out of it is an insult to their patriotism, and besides they have been pretty well looked after by the present administration in giving life positions to deputy revenue collectors, pension examiners and postoffice inspectors, all of whom are sound money democrats. This is simply another one of his schemes to stir up feeling against Thurston. Anin is no doubt a bright sort of man, but he is not of the material of which history makers are made."

Then when you die, after having stood round for years and sneered at the editor and his little jim crow paper, be sure and have your wife send in for three extra copies by one of your weeping children, and when she reads the generous and touching lies about you, forewarn her to send 15 cents to the editor. It would overwhelm him. Money is corrupting and what he wants is your heart felt thanks. Then he can thank the printers and they can thank the grocer. Take your job to the job office and then come and swap a complementary

ticket for a local announcement. Be sure and have the ticket marked not transferable, otherwise the editor might sell it and thereby get pay for his advertising. Get your lodge letter heads printed out of town or buy rubber stamps to print them with, and then flood the editor with beautiful thoughts in resolutions of respect and cards of thanks. They make such spicy reading, and when you pick it up filled with these glowing and vivid mortuary articles you are so proud of your little local paper. But money—score the filthy thing. Don't let the pure innocent editor know any thing about it. The editor gives his bounty away. The Lord loves a cheerful giver. He'll take care of the editor. The editor has a charter from the state to act as door mat for the whole community. He will get the paper out some way; stand up for the town, and whoop it up for you when you run for office. Don't worry about the editor; he'll get on. The Lord knows how—but somehow."
