Upon receipt of orders from Manila General Miller sent native commissioners ashore from the United States transport, St. Paul with a communi cation for the rebel governor of Ibilo calling upon him to surrender in the time stated and warning him not to make a denonstration in the interval. The rebels immediately took up arms and prepared to defend their position. The Petral then fired two warning guns and the rebels opened fire upon her. 


