Apple Blanc Mawge.—One qt of stewed apples mashed fine, add 1 cup of melted butter, 1 cup of sugar, lemon flavor, 4 eggs well beaten.

FRANCHISE TO THE NEBRASKA TELEPHONE COMPANY.

SEC. 1. That the Nebraska Telephone Company be, and are hereby granted right of way for the erection and maintenance of poles and wires, with all the appurtenances thereon.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall interfere with, cut, remove, injure, break or destroy any of the poles, wires, fixtures, instruments or other property of any telegraph or telephone company or association within the corporate limits of this village, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
