A LATE PICTURE OF SECRETARY TAFT.

William Howard Taft, secretary of war and leading Republican presidential candidate, was born in Cincinnati Sept. 15, 1857. A graduate of Yale and Cincinnati Law school, he began work as a reporter. In 1887 he became judge of the superior court of Cincinnati; in 1890 he was appointed United States solicitor general; in 1892 he became United States circuit judge; in March, 1900, he went to the Philippines, to organize the American government there; Feb. 1, 1904, he was appointed secretary of war. He has rendered conspicuous service in the Philippines; in negotiations with Pope Leo; in Cuba; in Panama, and to American interests throughout the world.

The National Republican convention convened in Chicago Tuesday of this week.

Is it not about time some patriotic republican of this senatorial district issued his manifesto as candidate for the toga, or words to that effect?

Gov. Hughes has won out in his war on the race-track gambling, both houses having passed the bills, and the governor attached his signature to the bills making them law.

Bryan is opposed to a prohibition plank in the democratic platform, and that settles the question of such a plank being placed there. He says he does not regard the question as one of National importance.

We hear it whispered that Editor Brown of the Times-Independent hears the political bee buzzing in his ear and may hit his castor into the ring again this fall as successor to himself as representative from Sherman county.

The entries in the live stock departments for the coming State Fair, Aug. 31 to Sept. 4, now give promise of an excess over those of prior years. Applications in the swine department far exceed the capacity of the 714 pens on the grounds. The horse barns are about filled and entries of cattle are pouring in daily.

Last Friday morning's State Journal like the Kearney Hub of some weeks since, credits the "Don't cheer, boys; can't you see the poor fellows are dying," to Fighting Bob Evans, when the famous saying should instead be credited to Capt. Phillips of the Texas, at Santiago. Why can't our big brethren of the press keep history straight?

G. H. Kinsey was down from Arcadia last Friday and says he feels quite sure the republican boys of his district will easily accord him the senatorial nomination: A visit up in Custer county shows very satisfactory conditions regarding his candidacy. Our exchanges as a unit speak very favorably of him, even the opposition papers being courteous and complimentary in their mention.

Dayid B. Hill, one of the greatest democrats this country ever had in late years, claims democracy is dead and dates its disintegration from the convention of 1896, when Bryan was nominated for president. He says: "The democratic party never wanted Bryan. Bryan wanted the democratic party. He forced himself on the party in 1896 and again on what was left of the party in 1900 and now in 1908 he calls himself the democratic party."

The democrats over in the third congressional district will evidently show themselves hard up for proper congressional timber if they allow the redoubtable Edgar Howard of the Columbus Telegram to win at the primaries. If there ever was a more self-conceited, over-rated bumpkin than that long-haired, shallow-pated, drawing would-be philosopher of a mildewed, moss-covered party, he has never been brought to the front in any party in Nebraska. While democracy has ever been the party of fatal mistakes, they surely will not be so foolish as to select such easy picking for the republicans at this congressional district.

The Union Pacific and B. & M. roads are making a vigorous protest against the tax valuations upon their properties in many of the counties through which their lines run. Among them is Sherman county, and the kick is registered over the valuations made by the Loup City and Rockville assessors by the U. P. The B. & M. makes no complaint in this county.

Victor Rosewater of the Omaha Bee was selected as national committeeman for Nebraska by the delegates to the National Republican convention. Allen W. Field was chosen as Nebraska's member of the committee on resolutions. Governor Sheldon was made chairman of Nebraska's delegation. The delegation decided to present Gov. Sheldon's name as candidate for vice-president. Senator Norris Brown making the nominating speech.

At the head of our columns this week we place the picture of the next president of the United States, in the person of Wm. H. Taft, present secretary of war. By the time this paper reaches our subscribers, there is not the least doubt but that Mr. Taft will have received the republican nomination for chief executive at the hands of the National Republican convention in session now in Chicago. Just who will receive the nomination for vice-president is yet up in the air, with a dozen prominent men mentioned, and no one of them with any perceptible lead over the others. That nomination will probably come this afternoon or tomorrow.

Some weeks since, the Northwestern mentioned the selection of W. R. Mellor as president of the St. Paul Oratorio Society of Lincoln, an organization of the best musical talent of that city. His sentiments were heartily applauded. The Society is to be congratulated upon Mr. Mellor's acceptance of the presidency. He is a man of great executive ability as is evinced by the unprecedented success of the State Fair for the last two years. He has a true powerful bass voice of great range and fine quality. He has a great heart which beats in sympathy with all mankind. With all these qualities it is not too much to expect that under his leadership the St. Paul Oratorio Society will grow to be one of the leading musical organizations in the country."

Tornado on Cole Creek

Last night about 6 o'clock a small twister swooped down on Cole Creek in Washington township, striking at L. Domgard's first, moving his house 10 feet and badly wrecking it, moving the barn and horses several rods, tearing the windmill to pieces, besides wrecking outbuildings killing a calf a number of hogs and chickens, scattering wreckage of buildings for half a mile in the path of the storm, and big trees north of this place were blown down and torn out by the roots. At J. P. Ford's it wrecked a number of outbuildings, tearing a corn crib down and scattered the contents, his windmill also being wrecked. At Will Mizner's it tore a big hog shed to pieces, but no serious damage. The twister traveled northeast. A barn of a Mr. Hill on Clear Creek was blown off, a board striking him on the head, injuring him so a physician had to be called. Up to the hour of going to press we have not heard of further particular damage, no fatalities, nor others injured. We are under obligations to Carrier J. W. Conger for the above news by phone.

Tornado Near Boelus.

On Thursday night of last week our people were startled by the news that the house of E. P. Enevoldsen, three and one-half miles northwest of Boelus, had been destroyed by a wind storm. Parties immediately went out there and found that the buildings on the place had been in the center of a wind storm, demolishing the house and other buildings, killing both Mr. and Mrs. Enevoldsen.

Friday morning Anton Rask, Carl Petersen, John and F. W. Berk drove out to the scene of the wind storm. The buildings on the Enevoldsen farm, the house and barn which were but recently constructed, were nothing but a mass of kindling wood nearly all having been piled up in a draw northeast of the house where also the bodies of Mr. and Mrs. Enevoldsen had been found. Only the windmill tower was standing and around it had been piled nearly all of the farm machinery in a jumbled mass similar to a scrap pile. Pieces of two-by-fours had been driven into the ground to a depth of five or six feet. From there the party drove to the former Berk place, one and one-half miles from the Enevoldsen place, where conditions were in pretty much the same shape, the improvements all torn to pieces. The tenant, Ed. Towsley, with his family had saved their lives by taking refuge in a cave. The path of the storm still continued north, the next place being hit was the Mads Madsen place but the buildings at this place seemed to have escaped the fury of the terrible wind.

At the George Sorensen place the house escaped, but other buildings were damaged considerably. At Mrs. Swander's place considerable injury was done to the improvements, the orchard being destroyed and trees twelve to sixteen inches in size torn from the ground as if they had been weeds. The storm seems to have had its start near the Loup river in Sherman county and traveled in a northeasterly direction crossing the county line into Howard county, its path being about six or eight miles in length, but only a few rods in width. The wind storm was followed by about four inches of rain which did considerable damage, washing out crops and roads.—Danneberg News.

Obituary--Jost Blumer

Died, Jost Blumer, June 12, 1908, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Theo. Wehe, Ashton, Neb. Deceased was born in Switzerland, March 6, 1832. Landed in New York City April 12, 1865, (the same day President Lincoln was shot), moving at once to Davenport, Iowa, where he resided ten years. In 1875 he moved with his family to what is now the village of Ashton. He was married in 1855, which union was blessed with 13 children, 10 of whom survive him, five sons and five daughters, as well as the widow. The remains were laid to rest in Mount Hope Cemetery June 16, 1908, followed by one of the longest processions ever seen in Ashton. The pall-bearers were H. Smelser, H. Dunker, J. Albers, A. Beushausen, S. Badura and J. Nelmann.
