JUDGE HOWELL RE-INSTATED

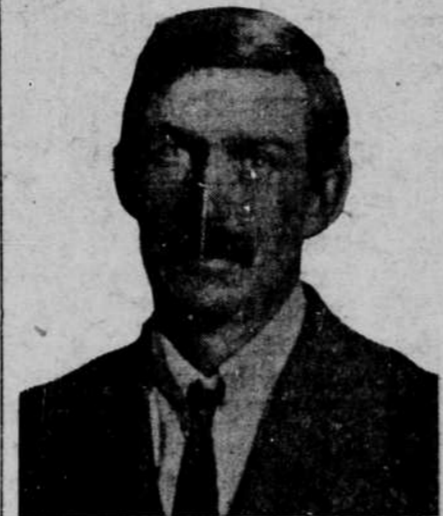
