The engagement of Katharine New-  
 branch, '19, to Howard Douglas, of  
 Omaha, was announced at a dinner  
 given in her honor at the home of her  
 mother in Omaha Saturday afternoon.  
 Twenty-four guests attended the re-  
 ception, including many Omaha mem-  
 bers of Alpha Phi, of which sorority  
 Miss Newbranch is a member.

Miss Newbranch was one of the  
 most widely known students of the  
 University, and was a member of  
 Theta Sigma Phi, Black Masque and  
 Silver Serpent. She was also editor-  
 in-chief of the Daily Nebraskan in  
 1918, being one of the first women to  
 hold that position. Mr. Douglas was  
 graduated from the Omaha Central  
 High School, and is engaged in busi-  
 ness with his father in Omaha.
