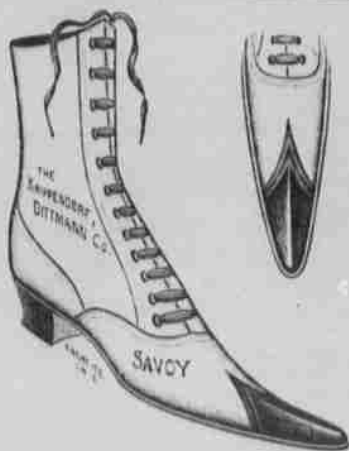
A HIGH GRADE CONSERVATORY where only first class musical instruction is given, and at half the expense of other institutions of the same kind.
