

STATE INTERCOLLEGIATE.

Four state records were broken at the intercollegiate Saturday. The unfavorable condition of the grounds prohibited extra fast time on the runs. The university won first place in all of the twelve events, and second in eight, making a score of eighty-four points. Doane college was second with thirteen points, and York, third, with five, Wesleyan last with three.

Records were broken in the hammer throw, discus throw half mile run and 120 yard hurdle. The summary of events is as follows:
