It is the aim of the Preparatory School to secure thoroughness in the elementary branches and a broad and substantial foundation for higher education.

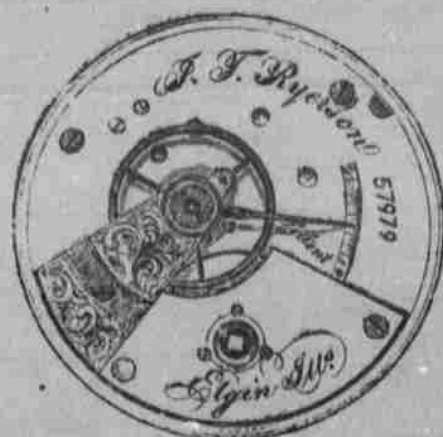
It is the aim of the Normal School to carry the work of general education to as high a standard as the time will admit, and to secure skill and ability in the special work of teaching and school management.
