No. 42 going north at 11:50 a. m. will leave at 11:59 p. m.

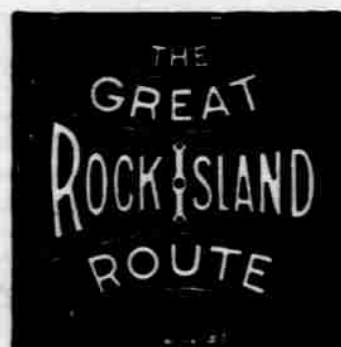
No. 43 going south at 5:55 will leave at 6:05 p. m.
