A St. Paul, Minn., dispatch carried by the Associated Press says: "Attorney General Young today obtained from the county court a writ of mandamus directed against the Northern Pacific Railroad company to compel it to comply with the commodity rate law whose operation was enjoined by Judge Lochren of the United States court. The railroad officials will probably ask Judge Lochren for an order citing Attorney General Young for contempt of the United States court. If the attorney general is declared in contempt a writ of habeas corpus will be issued and the matter taken to the United States supreme court for final decision as to the state's right to regulate rates."
