Consul General John L. Griffiths of London has made a report on English postal savings bank for the year 1908. From this report the following synopsis was made by Arthur W. Dunn, Washington correspondent for the St. Louis Star: "With more than three-quarters of a billion dollars of the people's savings deposited in her postal savings banks, England is very well satisfied. The most interesting facts presented by Consul General Griffiths are as follows: In 1908 there were 18,379,991 deposits, aggregating \$217,877,011, and \$9,922,-169 withdrawals, aggregating \$220,-916,714. The amount withdrawn during 1908 exceeded the amount deposited by \$3,039,703, but in 1907 when financial conditions were less stable the amount withdrawn exceeded the amount deposited by \$10,-785,838. The total sum to the credit of the 11,018,251 depositors in the postoffice savings bank on December 31, 1908, was \$781,794,533. Friendly societies opened 227 accounts in the British postoffice savings bank in alegue free.
