SCHEDULE C

Metals and Mfrs of Metals

Table with 2 columns: Article, O. R.—N. R. Items include pig iron, scrap iron, ferromanganese, chromium metals, slab iron, bar iron, round iron rods, charcoal bars, iron beams and other structural shapes of iron or steel, boiler plate, sheet iron or steel, steel saw plates, anchors, forgings, antifriction balls, hoop iron, barrel hoops, steel, iron, iron or steel bands, railway fishplates, galvanized iron or steel sheets or plates, galvanized hoop, band, or scroll iron, hammered iron, copper or steel sheets, pickled iron or steel sheets, polished iron or steel sheets, cold rolled iron or steel sheets, cold rolled bands and strips, other cold rolled sheets, plates and steel, cold hammered strips, plates, and sheets of iron or steel, coated sheets or plates (tinplate), steel ingots made by Bessemer or similar process, steel bars and shapes made by Bessemer or similar process, steel ingots, made by crucible, electric or cementation process, steel shavings, iron or steel grit, shot and sand, rivet, screw, fence, nail, and other wire rods, cold rolled bars, round iron or steel wire, wire (except gold or silver) silk covered, cold hammered wire, coated wire, iron or steel, articles made of wire, telegraph and telephone wires, wire heads, wire rope, anvils, iron or steel, automobiles, value over \$2,000, automobile bodies, automobiles, value under \$2,000, automobile chassis, automobiles, finished parts, bicycles, motorcycles, axles and parts of, blacksmith hammers, tongs and sledges, bolts, iron and steel, nuts and nut blanks, nut washers, spiral nut locks and nut washers, card clothing, made with round iron, card clothing, with tempered steel or plated wire, cast iron pipe, cast iron pipe, cast iron andirons, iron castings, malleable iron castings, cast hollow ware, chains of all kinds, sprocket and machine chains.

SCHEDULE D

Wood and Manufactures of Wood

Table with 2 columns: Article, O. R.—N. R. Items include briar root and similar wood, veneers of wood, mahogany and other cabinet woods, sawed, unmanufactured woods (N. S. P. F.), paving posts, railroad ties, telegraph and other poles, casks, barrels, packing boxes & c., barrels and boxes containing oranges, &c., chair cane and rattan reeds, basket maker's willow, willow furniture, other willow manufactures, toothpicks, butcher's skewers, porch and window blinds of bamboo, &c., other bamboo blinds, same, if painted, house or cabinet furniture of wood, mfr's of wood.

SCHEDULE E

Sugar, Molasses and Mfrs. of

Table with 2 columns: Article, O. R.—N. R. Items include Philippine sugar, sugar, dutiable, until March 1, 1914, March 1, 1914 to May 1, 1916, after May 1, 1916, molasses, dutiable, until March 1, 1914, March 1, 1914, to May 1, 1916, after May 1, 1916, cane syrups, same as sugar rates above, maple sugar and syrup, glucose or grape sugar, sugar cane, until May 1, 1916, sugar cane, after May 1, 1916, saccharin, sugar candy and confectionery, worth under 15c lb., sugar candy and confectionery, worth over 15c lb., chewing gum.

SCHEDULE F

Tobacco and Manufactures of

Table with 2 columns: Article, O. R.—N. R. Items include wrapper and filler tobacco unstemmed, cheaper filler tobacco, unstemmed, filler tobacco stems, cheaper, wrapper tobacco, stemmed, scrap tobacco, all other tobacco, snuff and snuff flour, cigars, cigarettes, and all kinds of cheroots.

SCHEDULE G

Agricultural Products—Provisions

Table with 2 columns: Article, O. R.—N. R. Items include cattle, horses and mules, horses and mules, worth under \$200, horses and mules, worth over \$200 a head, other live animals, barley, barley malt, barley, hulled, macaroni, oats, oatmeal and rolled oats, oat hulls, rice, cleaned, rice, uncleaned, rice, paddy, rice flour, wheat, bran and wheat screenings, sweetened biscuits and cakes, butter and its substitutes, cheese and its substitutes, beans, beets, sugar, all other beets, prepared beans and peas, mushrooms, vegetables, cut or pickled, fish paste or sauce.
