

Women's health conference slated

To help women take a "decision-making role in their health care," the Lincoln-Lancaster Commission on the Status of Women is sponsoring a Women's Health Con-

The Oct. 30 conference will cover nutrition, childbirth. breastfeeding, menopause, mental health and how to survive a hospital stay.

"Medicine seems to have gotten out of control of people in general," said Chris Funk, chairwoman of the commission's health committee. "We hope by sharing our experiences we will take away some of the fears women

"For instance, the women will be taught that it's okay to question what a doctor tells them and that they don't have to take everything they are told verbatism," Funk

All sessions will be led by women who are professionals in their fields, Funk said.

Many of the speakers are local nurses and also serve on the commission's Health Committee.

The commission, initiated by Mayor Helen Boosalis in January, is an advisory commission on the careers, education and personal growth of women.
