

Want something for free? Mini-courses will begin

A series of free computer minicourses will begin at UNL Monday. The courses are designed to provide experience in working with computers. Classes are open to undergraduates, faculty members and graduate students.

According to Stephanie McFarland, computer information specialist, nine different mini-courses will be offered. There are 40 to 15 students enrolled in each section, with class members being a mixture of those eligible.

Courses offered include CMS, a timesharing course, GRAFICS, which teaches plotting, mapping, and designing pictures; JCL (job control language), the IBM language everyone must learn to run computers and LEGIFORM used for thesis purposes.

McFarland said this course is helpful to those doing updating on papers.

All mini-courses are separate classes running for two weeks, each with one and a half hours for each class period.
