

Applications for Daily Nebraskan senior editorial positions are due Sunday at 5 p.m.

Senior editor positions include managing editor, news editor and associate news editors. Applications for photo chief and night news editor are due at the same time.

Applications for sports, entertainment, copy and layout editors, reporters, photographers, artists and columnists are due Wednesday, Dec. 14.




