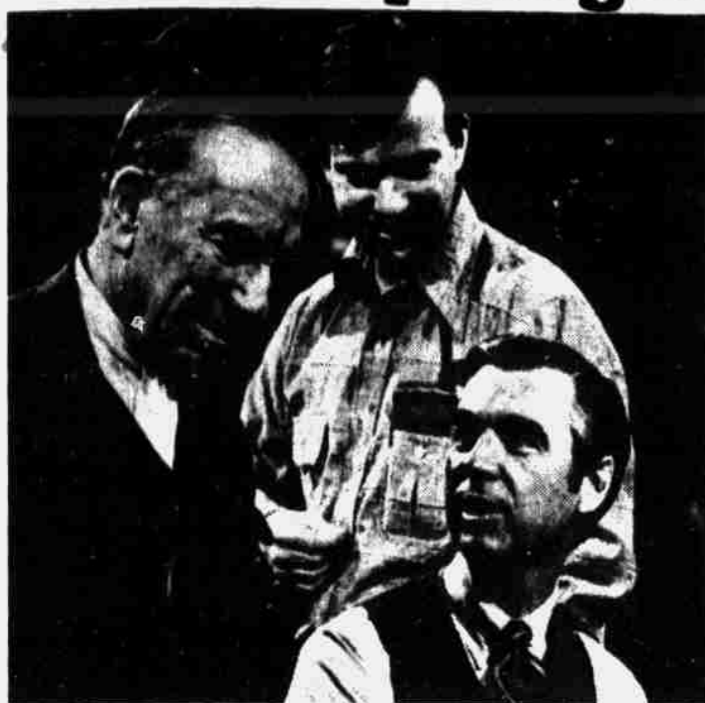


PBS in the spotlight

OLD FRIENDS...NEW FRIENDS. Fred Rogers' new weekly series about how people of various age groups live and grow with one another, will premiere Saturday, April 15, on PBS.

The first episode features Hoagy Carmichael (left), who composed all-time popular favorite songs such as 'Stardust' and 'Georgia on My Mind,' and Carmichael's son Hoagy B. (center), whose own life led him to become one of the world's best fishing-rod-makers. The premiere seeks to show what it is like to be the child of a famous, successful, career-oriented father, a complex, emotional fact of life which many of today's children and parents must try to understand.

Each of Rogers' (right) six successive OLD FRIENDS...NEW FRIENDS programs will deal with the impact of one person of whatever age in relation to another, his family or a broader community and how each benefits one from the other.

"In OLD FRIENDS...NEW FRIENDS we are going to present people who know who they are and can communicate their self-worth and their activities and accomplishments to others. Perhaps the most important matter in any person's life—at any age—is having a satisfying relationship with caring and trusted friends," Rogers writes. "What I want to achieve is to enlarge our viewers' circle of friends by helping them to understand enduring relationships and interactions between people of all generations. The generations, young and old, have so much to give each other, to learn from each other."

His luck turns with ferocity when he accidentally drives into a roadside shootout. Finding himself suddenly under attack by the police, he kills a deputy sheriff in self-defense. He is arrested and it soon becomes clear that the deck is stacked against him. The police deny the shootout ever happened, his lawyer insists he plea-bargain rather than plead innocent, and even Susan seems unable or unwilling to help.
