Baseball team hopes to top grid showing at Missouri

Remember just five months ago when Tom Osborne's Nebraska football team was riding high after a 20-17 upset of Billy Sims and the Oklahoma Sooners? The next week, however, Missouri upset the Husker gridgers, 35-31, in Columbia.

The loss cost Nebraska a chance to play Penn State for national championship.

John Sanders, whose baseball team has the best all-time Nebraska record of 39-6 this year, will take his team to Columbia Friday to play the same school that extinguished Osborne's title chances.

The Huskers are scheduled to play two doubleheaders against the 33-9 Tigers on Friday and Saturday. The series is an important one for the Huskers who lead the Big Eight Eastern Division with an 11-1

record, two games ahead of Missouri at 9-3.

Good NU pitching

"Certainly Nebraska is one of the best teams around," McArtor said. "They are solid in all phases of their game."

Missouri's top hitter is catcher Tim Laudner, a 406 hitter who leads the Tigers in home runs with four and RBIs with 41.

The Tigers' other top hitters include designated hitter Scott Collins, a .346 hitter, and speedy outfielder Phil Bradley. Bradley, who doubles as Missouri's football quarterback, engineered last year's grid upset.

Missouri's pitching ace is Tom Heckman, who is 8-1 and has a 1.14 ERA. McArtor said Heckman will pitch the first game against the Huskers on Friday. The Huskers have improved since last

year, when Missouri whipped Nebraska twice. Over half of the Husker lineup is hitting above .300, led by third baseman Jeff Hunter, a transfer from UNO. Hunter is hitting .372, has four home runs, and is second on the team with 41 RBIs.

Big Eight leader

First baseman Pete O'Brien leads the team and the Big Eight with 51 RBIs. O'Brien, a junior from Pebble Beach, Calif., is second in hitting with a .353 average, leads the team with six triples.

Speedy second baseman John Russo leads the club in doubles with 10 and stolen bases with 16.

Nebraska's pitching staff, with a 2.34 earned run average, is one of the best in the nation. The Huskers have posted 15 shutouts and have allowed one run in 12 games.

Six of the nine Nebraska pitchers have perfect records. Tim Pettit and Cliff Faust both have 5-0 records, and Jeff Costello, Mike Vojtesak, Jim McManus, and Gary Nolting have 4-0 slates.

Two of the Huskers' best pitchers, Ray Tromba and Tim Burke, have less than perfect records. Burke, a sophomore from Roncalli High School in Omaha, owns a 5-1 record with a 1.83 ERA. He leads the team with 53 strikeouts and is second to Tromba in innings pitched.

Tromba, a junior transfer from UCLA, has a 4-3 record. Two of those losses were to Hawaii's Derek Tatsuno, last year's major-college strikeout leader. His other loss was to Oklahoma State.

The ace Husker reliever is Gary Nolting, a junior from Millard. Nolting has struck out 35 hitters in 28 2/3 innings and has a 2.83 ERA.
