Mrs. Crosby did not give exact figures of her campaign donations but said she accepted no amount large enough to sway her votes in the Legislature.

"It's not big money. It's all out in the open," she said.

The candidate agreed on most of all of the women's issues offered although Mrs. Crosby said she was not pro-abortion. Oth-

er topics included legislation and funding for child care centers, credit for women and jobs for women coming out of retirement.

Sen. Fowler supported an increase in spending for child care centers and said, "I'm not talking about just babysitting services. What I think we need are child care services that meet standards of child educational growth."

He said the state should come up with money to further child care services in addition to that given Nebraska by the Federal Government through Title 20.
