CFA meets DN: budget explained

Representatives from the Daily Nebraskan met with the Committee for Fees Allocation Thursday night to explain the paper's functions, and it's use of student fees.

Dan Shattil, general manager for the Daily Nebraskan, said the purpose of the newspaper is to inform the campus community about events occurring in the area. He said it also acts as a learning experience for the 143 students working on the staff of 150.

Shattil said the Daily Nebraskan publishes 17,500 papers each day, with student fees accounting for 7 percent of the papers expenses, He said one issue of the paper costs \$3,200 to print. Student fees account for \$50 of the total costs, while advertising pays the remaining 97 percent of costs.

Student fees are used by the newspaper for

financial reasons, Shattil said, but also as a symbolic gesture showing the paper's accountability

In 1972, 36 percent of the Daily Nebraskan's budget came from student fees, Shattil said, as compared to 7 percent for the current year. The newspaper receives 90 cents per student each semester from the \$88.20 paid in student fees.

The Daily Nebraskan's policy is to minimize the amount of student fees through advertising, Shattil said, and through the years it has done so.

Shattil and Editor Larry Sparks conducted a tour of the newspaper's office to show several of the new purchases made by the paper. Computers for typesetting the paper and for the advertising and business department, plus a process camera and the Reuters wire service were a few of the items shown on the tour.
