Fullback Kaelin leads way for glamour backs

Nebraska football has been known for two things year in and year out: top-notch I-backs and a fullback leading the way.

Roger Craig, Mike Rozier and Jarvis Redwine are just a few Husker I-backs that come to mind. But people tend to forget that the Cornhuskers also have

produced an equal number of outstanding fullbacks. The Nebraska fullback is usually in the shadow of the more heralded I-back, quietly going about his business of crushing blocks and short-down yardage. This year's version is Ken Kaelin, a 5-10, 230-pound senior from Westerville.

Kaelin had been questionable to Nebraska coaches due to the rumor that he played eight-man football in

high school, something that is all but a myth.

"We only played one game with eight people, just to accommodate a county rival," Kaelin said, "but it was still pretty small-town football. I went from being the biggest guy around at Ansley to being one of the smaller guys at Nebraska," Kaelin weighed 190 in high school and has beefed up to 230 by being a fanatic weightlifter.

The Florida State game was Kaelin's first varsity game. He played back up to one of Nebraska's most prolific fullbacks ever, Tom Rathman.

Kaelin said he feels that his best assets are possessing consistency, strength and quickness. He said he didn't play as well as he wanted against Florida State, although he picked up 32 yards on five carries.

"In school I would always set goals for 1,000 or 2,000 yards. Now, I just want to contribute to the team and help us win in any way I can," Kaelin said.

"This year's team has a little different attitude. In years past we always knew we'd be up there in the rankings, but we just kind of let things happen," Kaelin said. "This year we're not looking ahead or anything, but it's definitely in the back of our mind."
