# Thursday Tennis season opens

Nebraska's women's tennis team will open its season Thursday by hosting the 1986 Husker Invitational. The tournament will run through Saturday, and the matches will be from 8 a.m. to approximately 6 p.m. each day.

Nebraska coach Kathy Hawkins said this will be an important tournament for Nebraska because it could determine where the Cornhuskers will be seeded in the Big Eight tournament. All the teams that face the Huskers are in the same region as Nebraska.

Hawkins said that all the teams

matched and that it should make the tournament very competitive.

Nebraska, which finished fourth in the Big Eight tournament last year, returns four letter-winners, including All-American Cari Groce. Last year, Groce and doubles partner Liz Mooney earned All-American status. They advanced into the quarter finals of doubles competition at the NCAA championships before being defeated by the Miami doubles team, 6-2, 6-1.

The other returning letter winners for Nebraska are Vickie Martin, Jill Pisarcik and Anne Stephens.

Nebraska has a basically young team wiht two seniors, one junior, two

playing in the tournament are evenly sophomores and two freshmen. The No. 1 singles player for Nebraska is Pisarcik. Pisarcik finished third in No. 2 singles and fourth in the doubles bracket with partner Vickie Martin at the Big Eight championships last year.

But Pisarcik is getting pressure from other players on the team for the No. 1 spot, Hawkins said. The competition should help the Huskers, she said, because the pressure will bring out the best from Pisarcik.

"Playing at home will be an advantage to us because we get a lot of support from boosters and parents," Hawkins said. "This will be a good experience for our team."
