NU goes for Big 8 title

Nebraska's volleyball team will travel this weekend to Penn Valley Community College in Kansas City, Mo., to try to win its 11th consecutive Big Eight Championship.

The No. 7 Huskers are 38-0 in Big Eight tournament play.

Nebraska coach Terry Pettit said his team will have to play consistently and not take anybody lightly if it is to win the Big Eight Championship.

The Huskers are coming off a second-place finish at the Wendy's Classic last weekend in Stockton, Calif., and are playing very well right now, Pettit said.

Pettit said that with the exception of the Huskers, the Big Eight is pretty even.

The Big Eight Championships are the most important tournament for the Huskers because if they win, they get an automatic NCAA tournament berth, he said.

"We prepare for the conference championships as if it's the most important tournament we play in,"

Pettit said. "If we didn't, our record wouldn't be what it is today."

The Huskers, in their 12th season, also will be going for another record, their 400th victory. Their overall record is 399-110, a .783 winning percentage. Pettit is in his 11th season at Nebraska. His record is 316-88 for a .782 winning percentage.

For the first time in Big Eight history, all six of Nebraska's starters were named to the All-Big Eight team. Seniors Tisha Delaney, Karen Dahlgren and Enid Schonewise were named to the first team. Named on the second team were Kathi DeBoer and freshman Virginia Stahr. Lori Endicott was selected as honorable mention.

It was the third time Dahlgren has been named to the All-Big Eight team. She is hitting .451 against Big Eight opponents and has 76 kills for the season. Schonewise is hitting .424 against Big Eight opponents and has 111 kills.

Pettit said last weekend's tournament in Stockton was a good tournament for the Huskers because it gave them a chance to play at the level of intensity needed for the Big Eight

Championships and the NCAA tournament.

The Huskers were picked by the Big Eight coaches to defend their Big Eight title successfully. The rest of the teams were picked as follows: Oklahoma, Kansas, Iowa State, Kansas State and Missouri in a tie, and Colorado.

The Huskers will play their first match Saturday at 6 p.m. against the winner of the Missouri-Iowa State game. The finals will be Sunday at 2 p.m. The Huskers are hitting .383 against Big Eight teams and are holding Big Eight opponents to a hitting percentage of .109.

Nebraska's Lori Endacott received honorable mention.

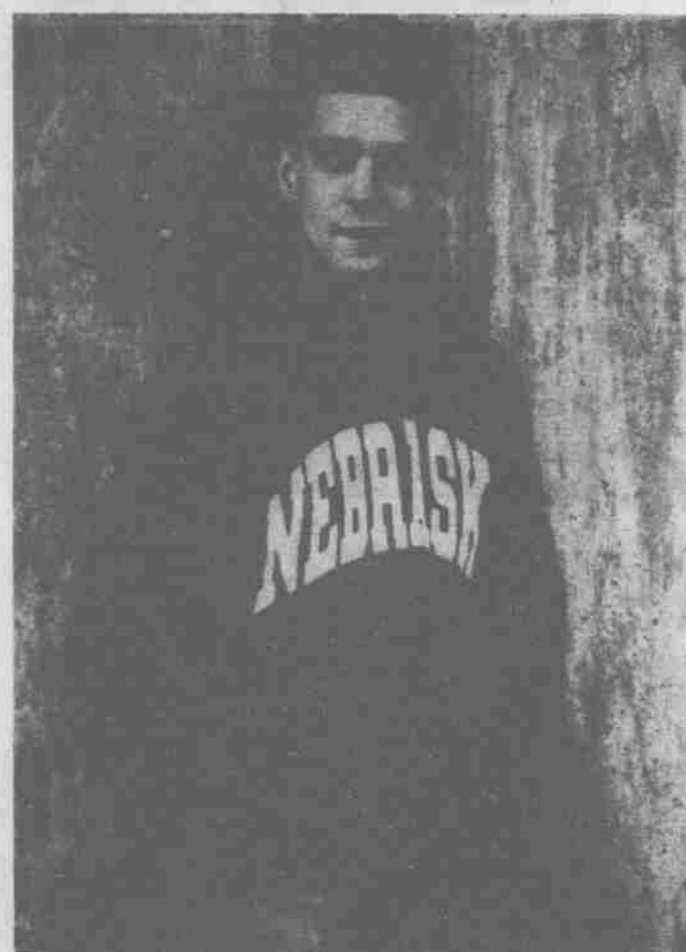
It was the first time all six starters from any team won Big Eight honors.
