Stone Sundae releases original rock album

With all the Lincoln bands playing rock 'n' roll, it takes some original sound to make a hard and heavy group sound cool and refreshing.

"We used to do the Grove thing," Peralez said. "Then we decided that we'd rather play our own stuff and let other people cover that someday.

"You can only play 'Hell's Bells' by AC/DC so many times," Brochtrup said.

"Doing cover is a waste of time," Hall said. "If you've got something to say, say it yourself."

Stone Sundae has something to say. The band has recently released their debut album "Praise" with 13 original songs.

"This album has a lot of feeling in it and really shows the diversity of our musicianship, Vanwey said.

"Everyone contributes to our songwriting," Peralez said.

"We'll all be throwing out ideas, and Eddie (Hall) will be scribbling away madly, and by the end of the night we'll have a new song," he said. The band has been trying to generate local
