Are due January 1st each year. First one-half delinquent May 1st. Second one-half delinquent September 1st. Delinquent real estate Tax List published the first week in October.

Watch the date of expiration of your driver's li-censes and have them renewed before they expire. They are good for two years from the date they are issued.
