Air Route to South America Is Established by Colombian Treaty

WASHINGTON— Signing of a reciprocal agreement between the United States and Colombia, permitting commercial airplanes of each country to fly over the other's territory, shattered the last official barrier to the extension of the Miami-Panama airmail route to Santiago, Chile.

Extension of the airmail route, for which contracts have been awarded Pan American Airways, Inc., will set up one of the longest and most hazardous commercial air lines in the world. It will make possible transportation of mail from New York, Chicago, Washington and other centers in the United States to the principal cities of Colombia, Ecuador, Peru and Chile within a few days instead of weeks and months now consumed in shipping mail and express to these points.

The mail will be flown from Miami, Fla., over the air trail that Lindbergh blazed on his inauguration of the Miami to Panama link in the Pan American system, across the Gulf of Mexico, through Central America, Panama, Colombia, Ecuador, along the coast of Peru

Finish Highway No. 50.

From Mitchell Republican. As published in The Evening Republican, the South Dakota highway commission is unable to make any promise as to the date of completion of highway No. 50, the trunk line running west through the Rosebud to a connection with Rapid City and on to Hot Springs.

Custer Battlefield Highway was completed two years ago and the Yellowstone Trail to the Black Hills not long after. It would seem that it is high time that highway No. 50 were also being finished.

Without doubt, the state highway commission has a difficult task in meeting the many demands made upon it from all parts of the state. No board connected with the government of South Dakota has made a finer record than the highway commission, in the opinion of this paper. Therefore, when it is urged that the highway body speed up No. 50, it should not be understood as unfriendly criticism.

From Panama, the airmail and express will be flown 3,400 miles along the western coast of South America, more than 1,000 miles farther than the route from Miami to Panama requires. The reciprocal agreement with Colombia, reached through an exchange of diplomatic notes between Enrique Olaya, Colombian minister, and Secretary of State Kellogg, is the first and only agreement of its kind negotiated with South American governments.

Concessions and agreements with the other countries concerned in the operation of the United States to Chile service have been made J. T. Trippe, president of Pan American Airways, Inc., operators of the new line.

Tri-weekly service in each direction will be established under terms of the contract, with further extension of the service provided if the volume of business warrants it. No passengers will be carried on the line until it is established as safe and practicable for passenger travel.

the Rosebud has not been completed is that the counties west of there have such small allotments that funds are not available to do the necessary work.

There can be no question about the truth of this statement. The solution of it is recognition of the fact that this is more a great deal more than a local highway for the counties through which it traverses. It is destined to be one of the important arteries to and from the Black Hills. When it is completed the popular route will be to the Black Hills over No. 50 and back the Custer Battlefield, or the other way around. In this way the tourist will find entirely different and most interesting scenery on the two highways. As it is now, one uses the Custer and the Yellowstone for the two trips journeys though country almost exactly alike on the two highways.

More than this, No. 50 will offer a short cut or the whole Rosebud to the Black Hills. This is particularly important since the Rosebud has no direct rail connection with the rest of South Dakota. A completed though highway therefore is to be the one link between it and the rest of the state. It is due the Rosebud to have this means of communication.

Eig Land Deal.

The Rapid City Journal reports the sale of a 5,400 tract of land in Bennett and Washabaugh counties to Minnesota parties, who are said to be planning extensive improvements. A turnover of this kind to outside investors is substantial evidence of the increasing interest being taken in South Dakota real estate.

The Milwaukee road in a recent bulletin reports the purchase of land for 11 Hungarian families in the vicinity of Kadoka. These families have been living in the coal mining districts of Ohio and Virginia, but originally they came from agricultural country in the old world and are anxious to get back to the land.

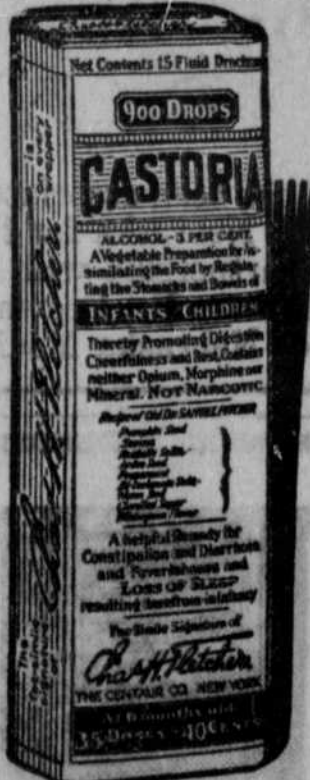
