To the Honorable Board of Supervisors:

In forming my judgment as commissioner on the within petition, I am taking into consideration both the public and private conveniences and inconveniences and expense of the within proposed line of road. Facts are:

That we have a county road No. 305 running north and south through this township 27 and 28 of Range 13. Our Road Record shows that the nearest platted road from the east to said county road No. 305 is on the township line 2 miles south and some 9 miles on the north, giving no access by public road to this county road to people from the east for the above named distance. It looks feasible that the people from the east should have some way of reaching this county road every two miles at least.

Therefore, I deem the proposed road prayed for in the petition practical and for the public good, and do herein recommend that the road be allowed as petitioned for herein.
